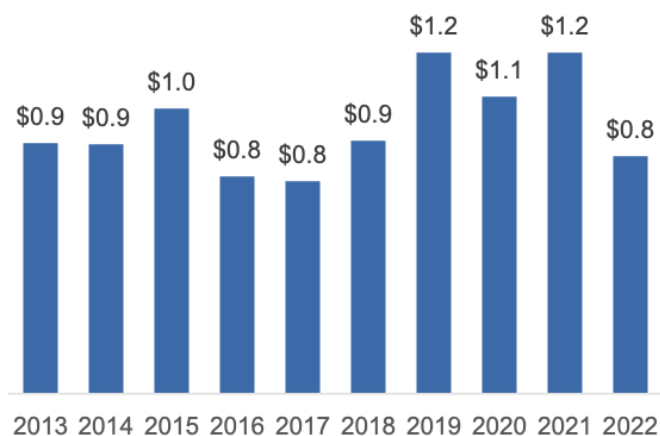


Connecticut's Exports to China

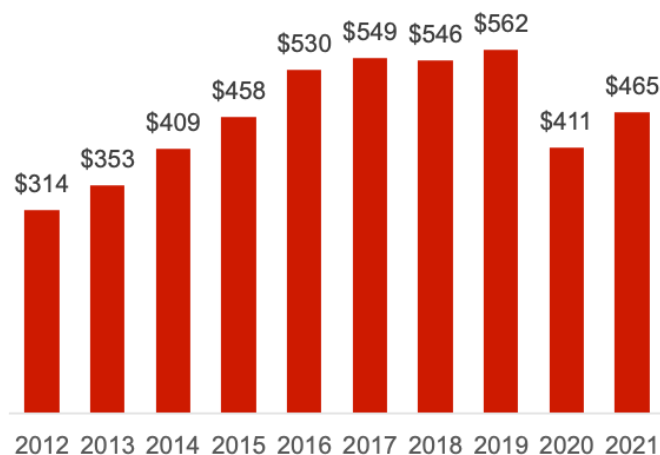

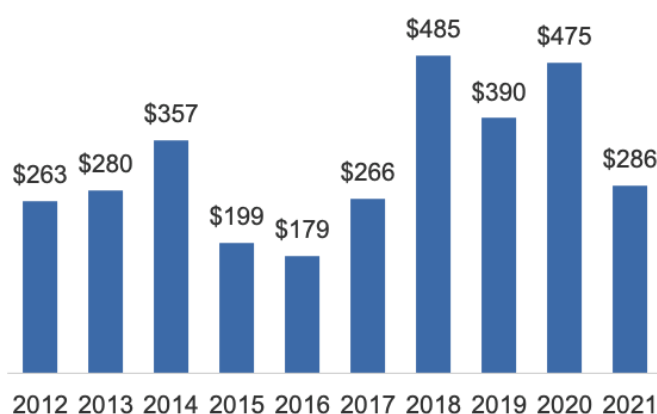

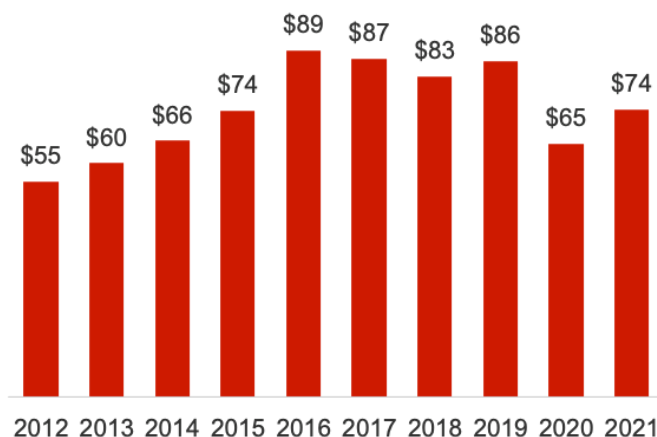

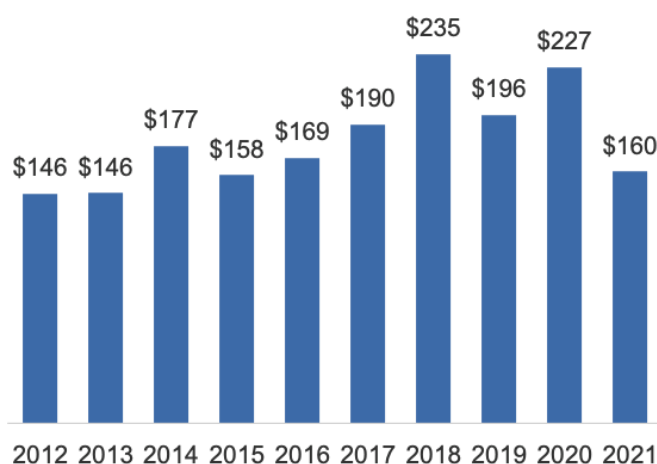

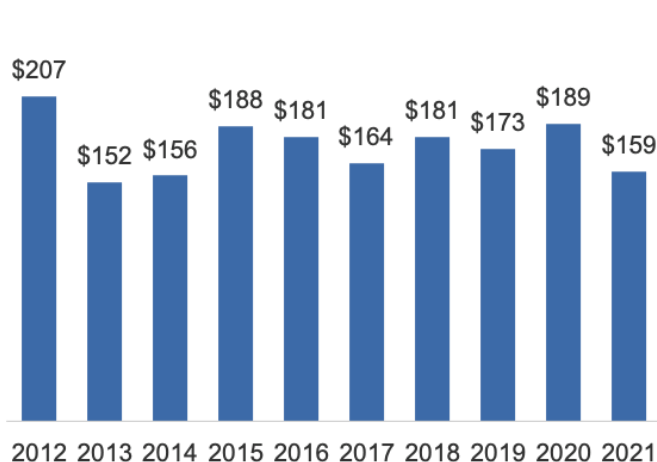

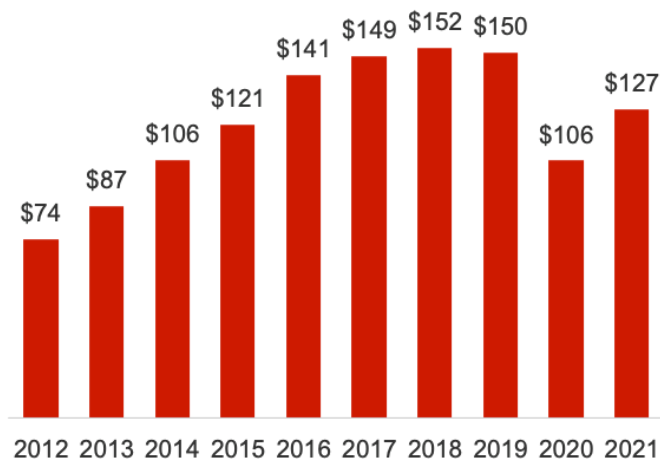

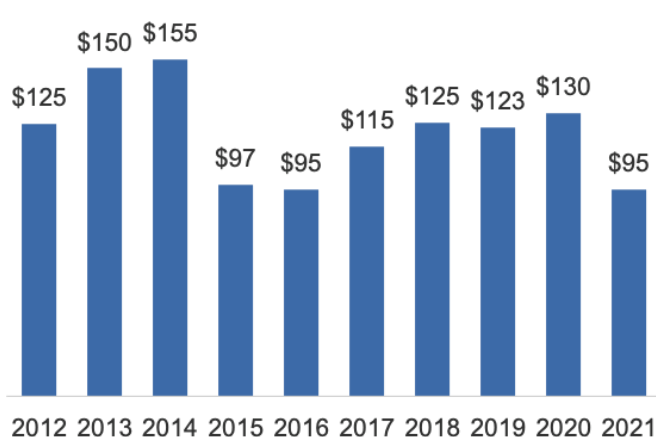

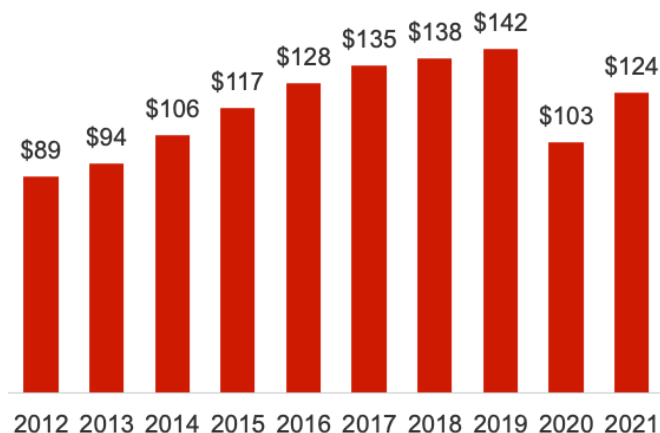

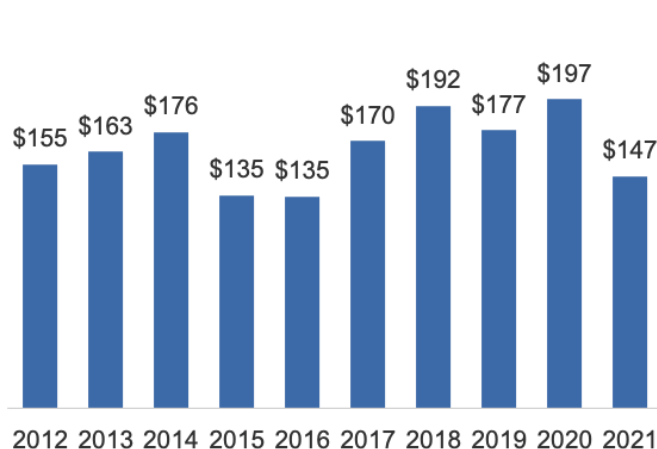

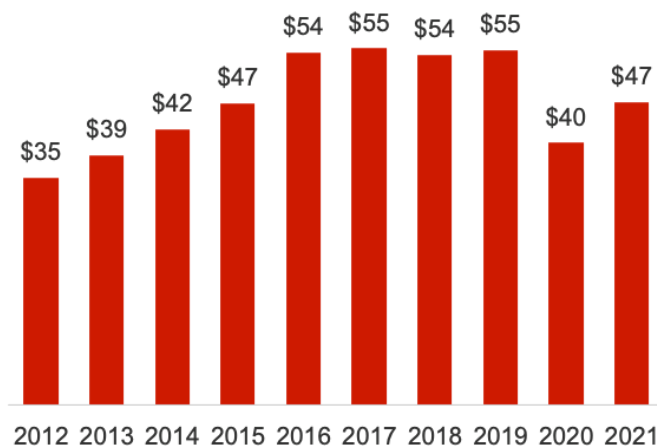
