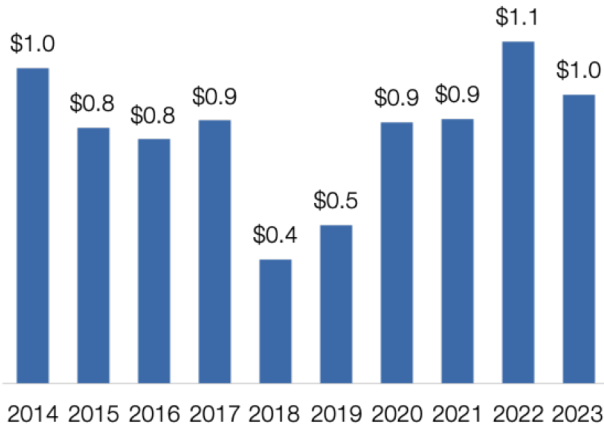


Arkansas' Exports to China

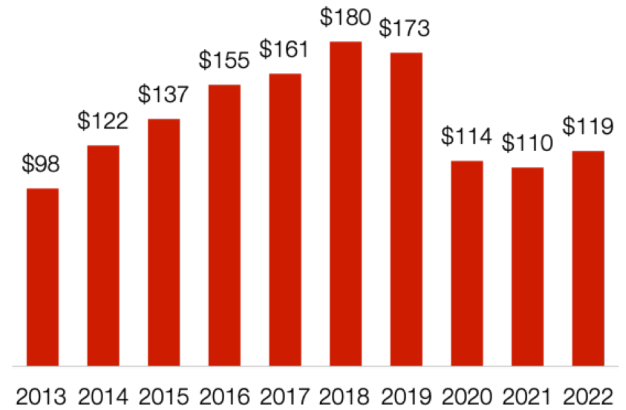
Arkansas' goods and services exports to China supported **8,000** American jobs in 2022.

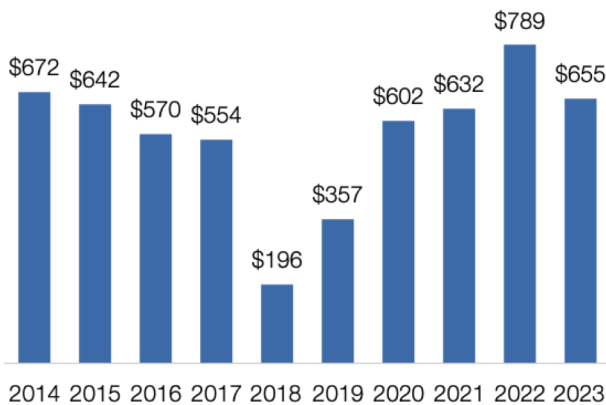

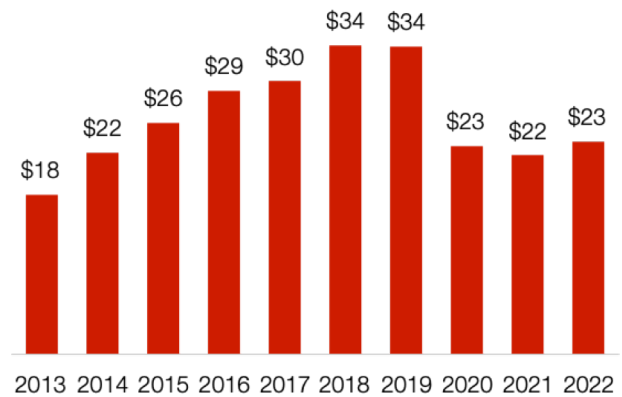
Arkansas' 1st District goods and services exports to China supported **5,490** American jobs in 2022.

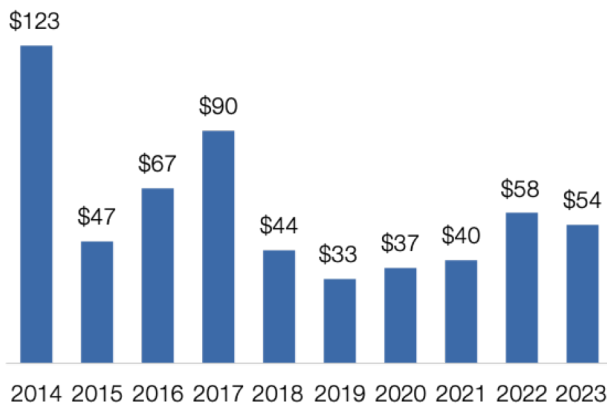

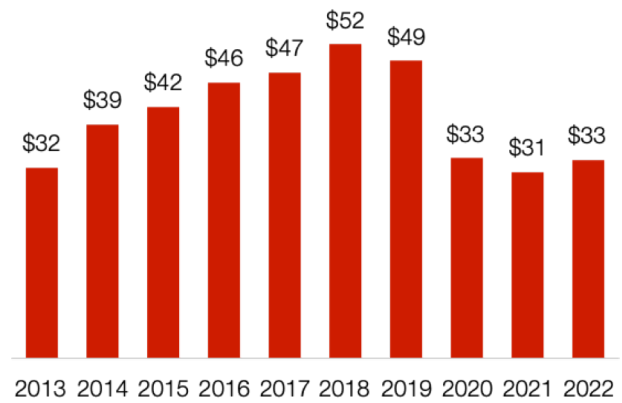

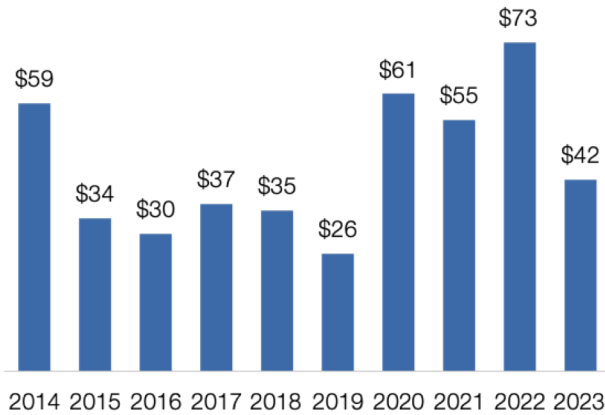

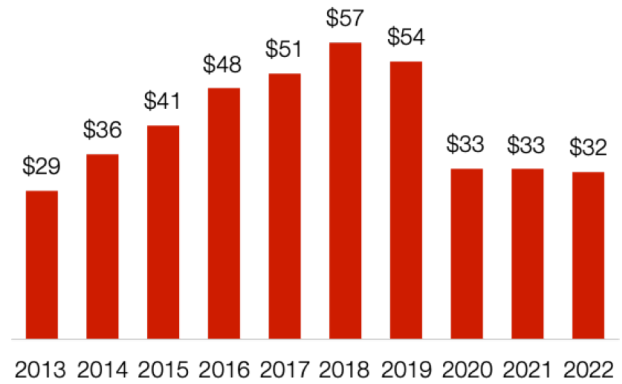
Arkansas' 3rd District goods and services exports to China supported **640** American jobs in 2022.

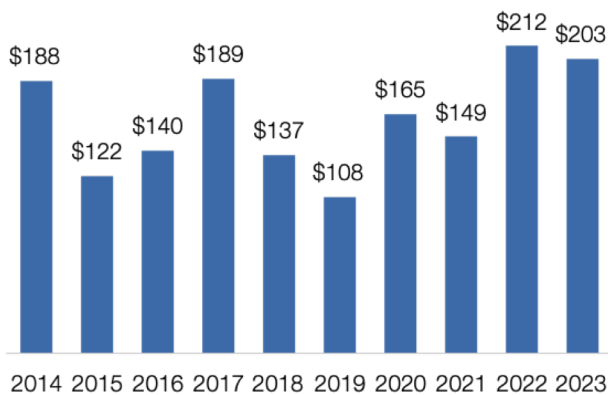

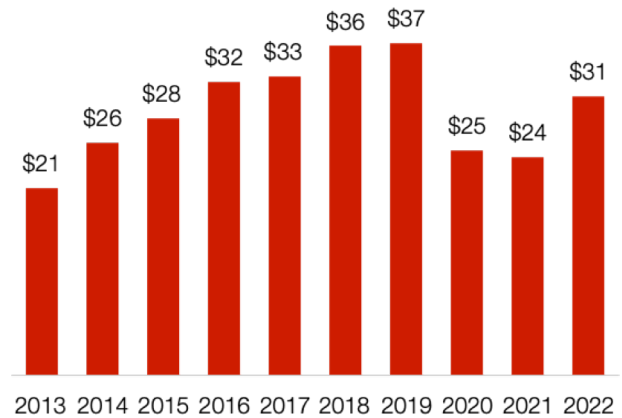
