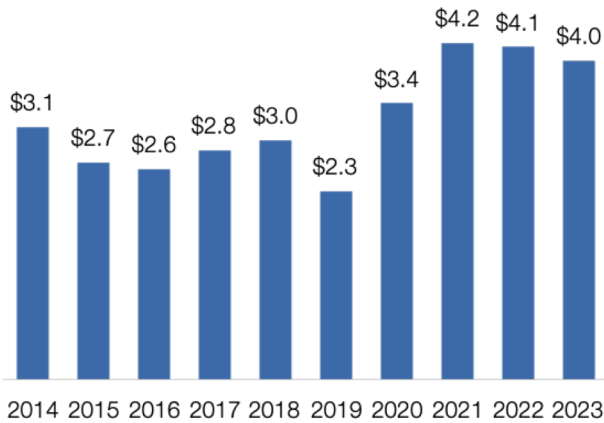


# Georgia's Exports to China

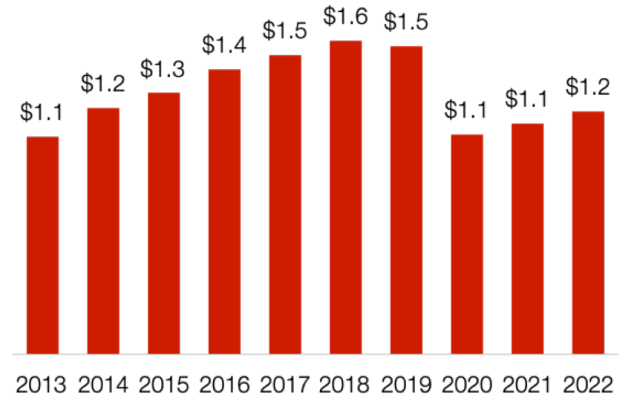
Georgia's goods and services exports to China supported **28,010** American jobs in 2022.

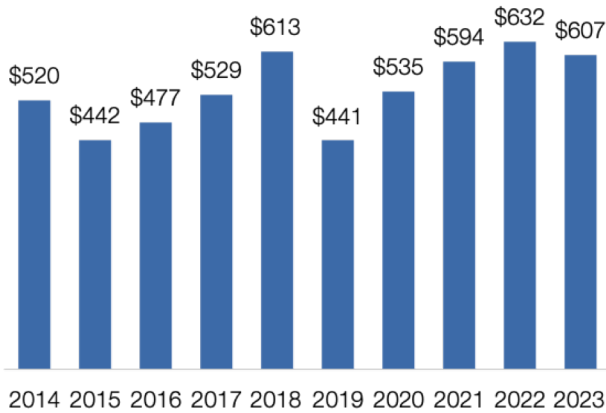

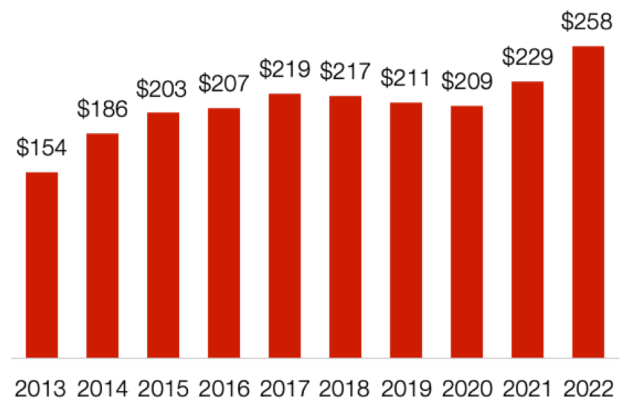

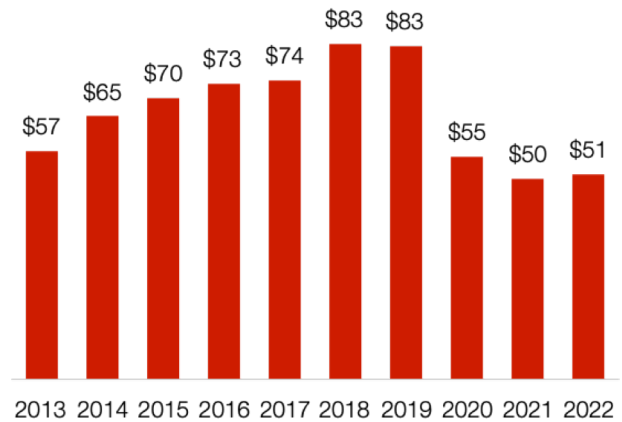

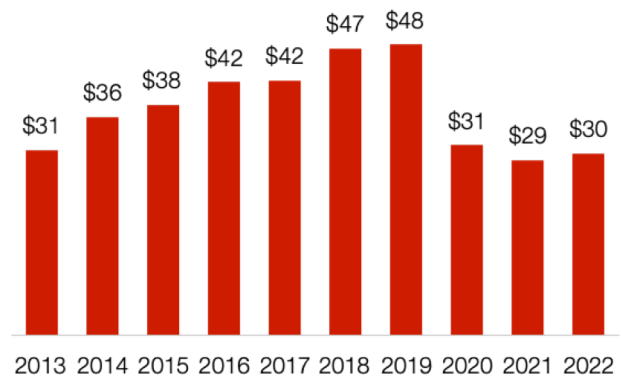

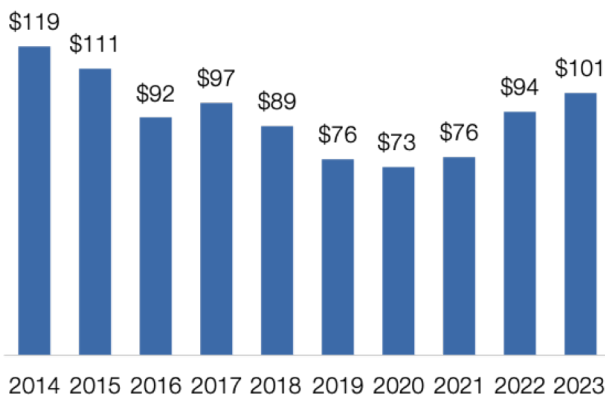

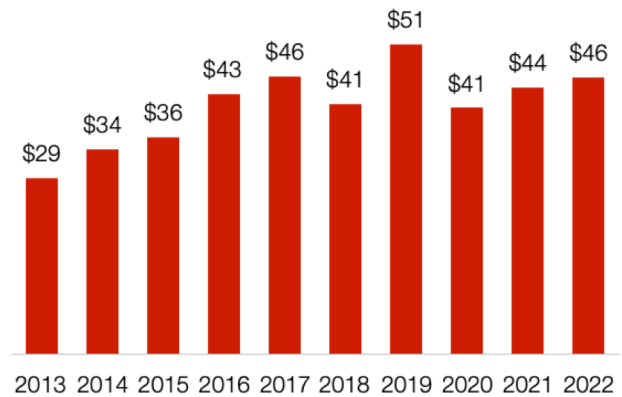

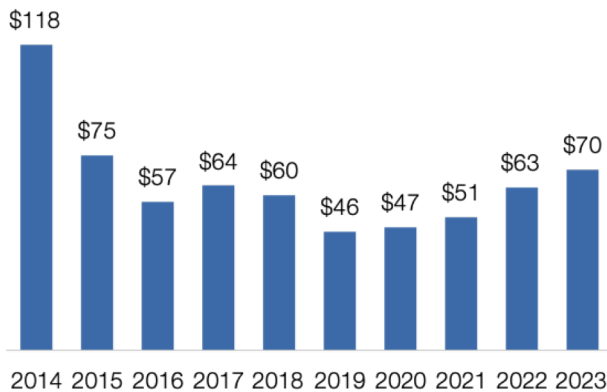

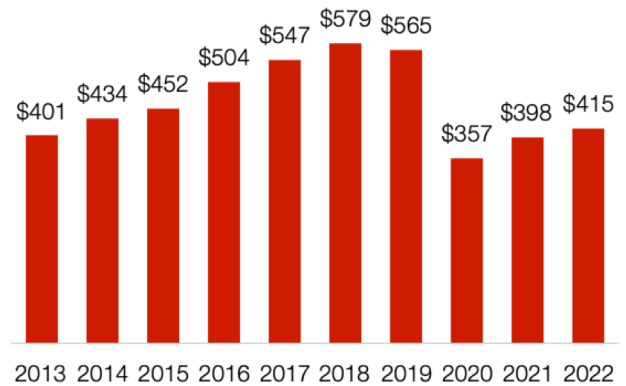

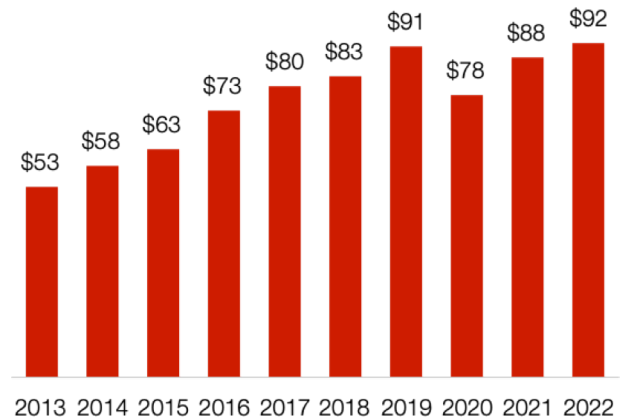

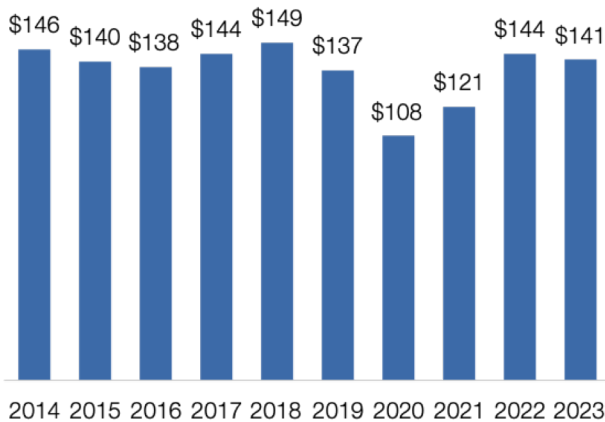

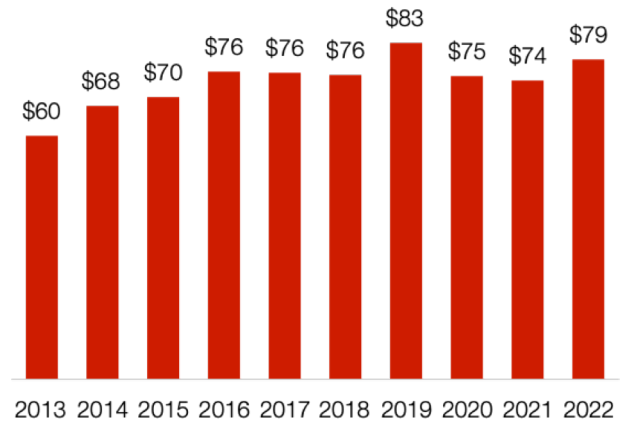

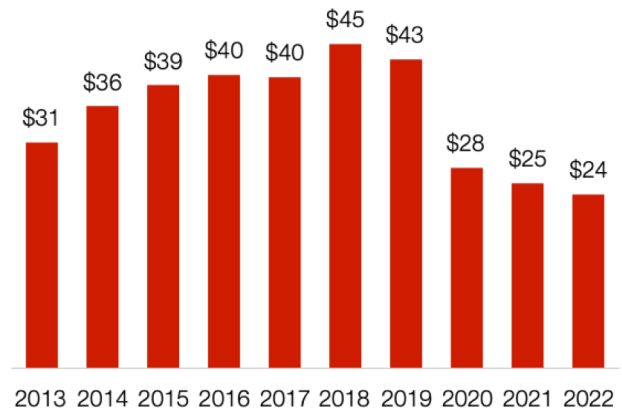

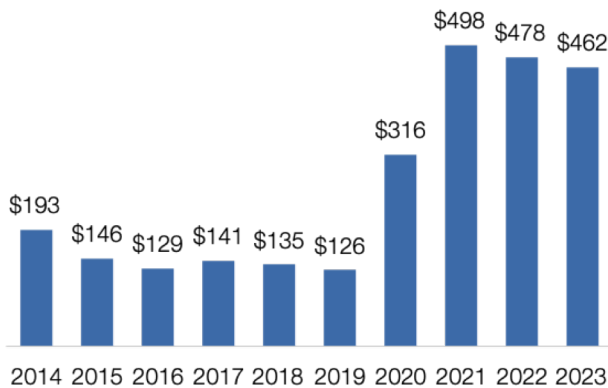

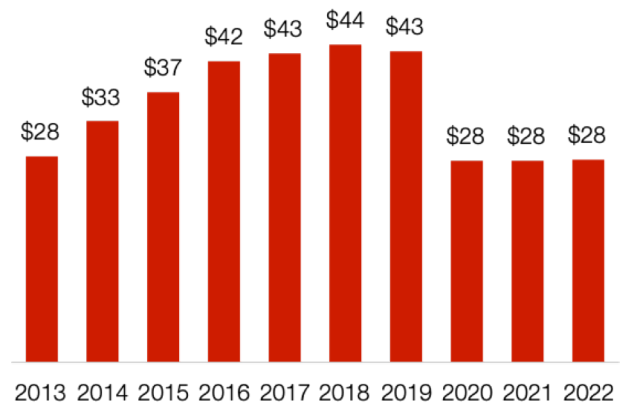

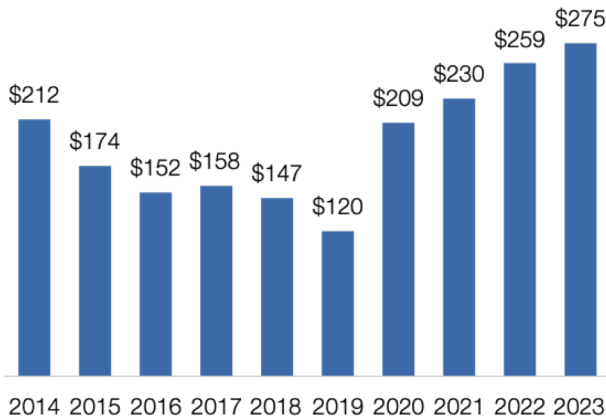

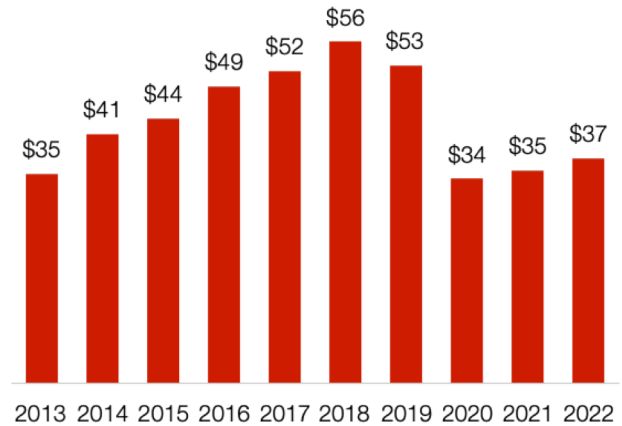

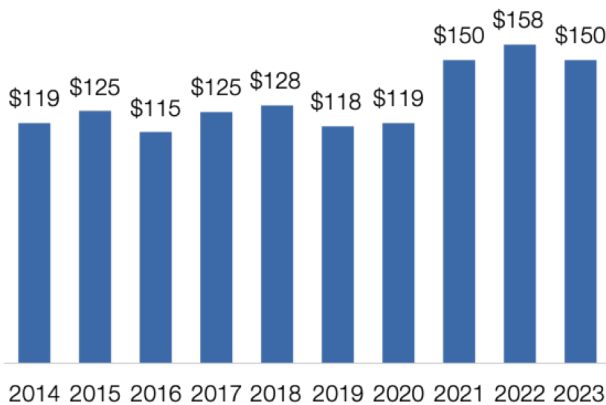

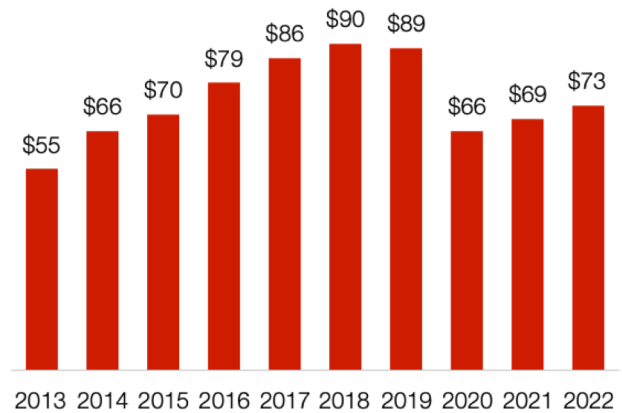

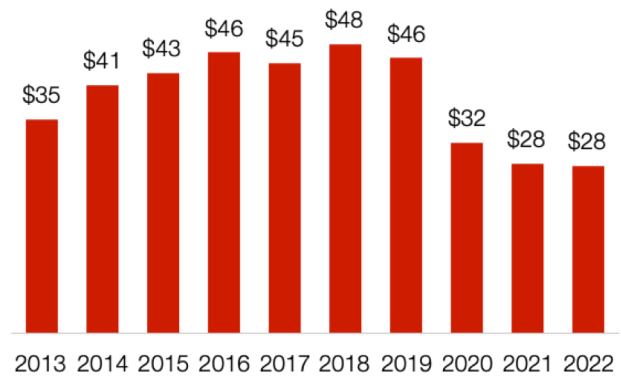

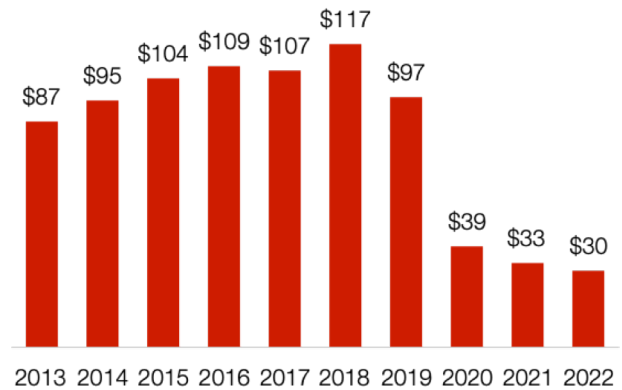

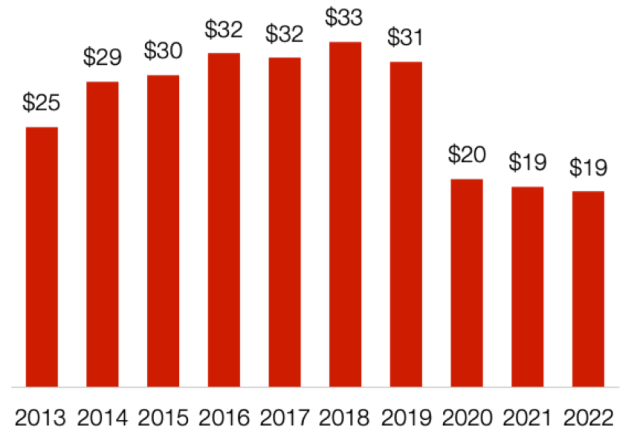
