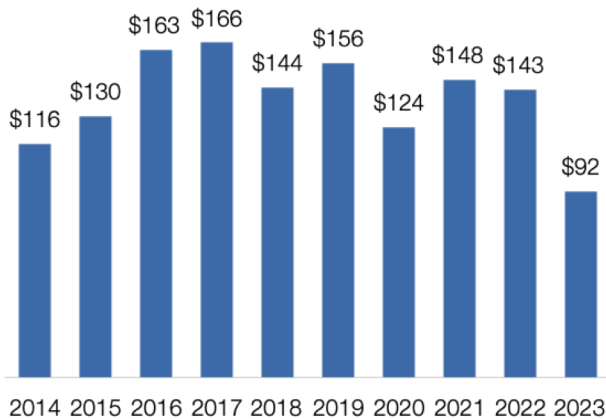


Rhode Island's Exports to China

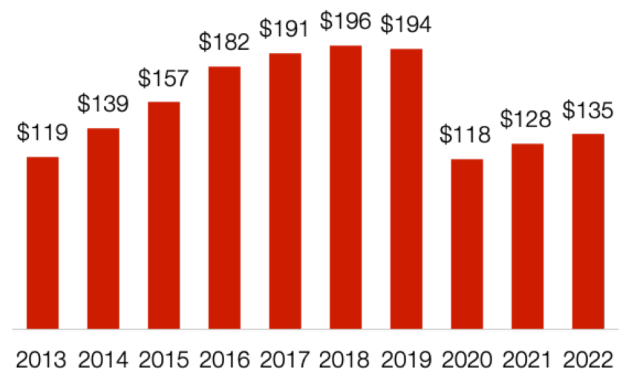
Rhode Island's goods and services exports to China supported **1,610** American jobs in 2022.

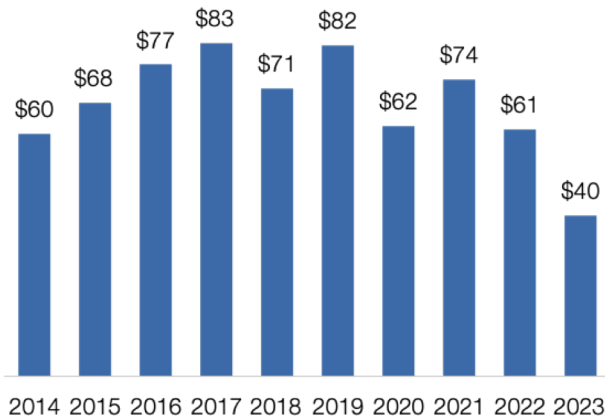

Rhode Island's 1st District Exports to China

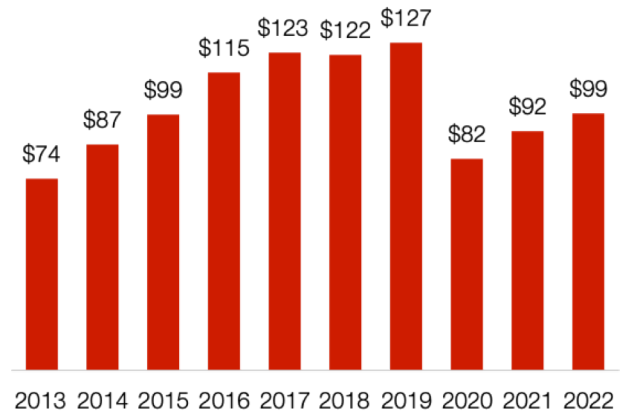
Rhode Island's 1st District goods and services exports to China supported **1,050** American jobs in 2022.

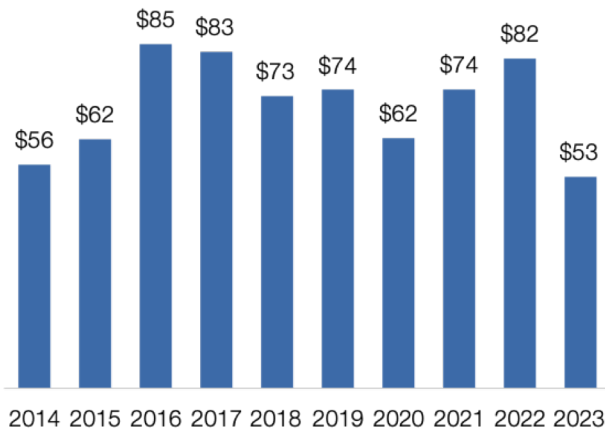

Rhode Island's 2nd District Exports to China

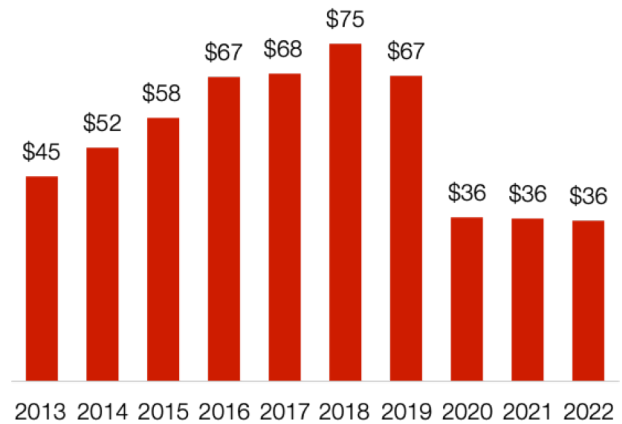
Rhode Island's 2nd District goods and services exports to China supported **560** American jobs in 2022.
